



A Draft of a tract of land Situated in Hopewell Township York County Penna Containing as above set forth 20 acres 9 perches and allowance

The part where the letter A is placed containing 16<sup>ac</sup> 74<sup>per</sup> and allowance being part of a tract of land originally surveyed on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of May 1765 by W<sup>m</sup> Matthews D.S. for Isaac Coulson in pursuance of a warrant for 100<sup>ac</sup> dated August 2<sup>d</sup> 1762.

The part where the letter B is placed containing 3<sup>ac</sup> 95<sup>per</sup> and allowance being part of a tract of land originally surveyed for Robert Eakens in pursuance of application N<sup>o</sup> 5482 for 100<sup>ac</sup> dated May 24<sup>th</sup> 1769.

Resurveyed the above on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February 1864 for John Logan the present owner who wishes to obtain a patent for the same.
