



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772. a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Thomas Hartley Esq^e on a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumb^{rs} marked in a General plan of said Tow. Number 136 Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of Dewberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South on Center Alley Two hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Dewberry Street aforesaid. Westward by Center Alley. Southw^d by Mulberry Alley and Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and Thirty five.

Returned into the Secretarys Office the 15th July 1774 by Warr^t. dated the same day
