



Whereas there was granted unto the above named Owen Hugh a Warrant for 25^{ac} of Land on y^e North Branch of French Creek in Union Township in Berks County dated the 3rd day of June 1772 but upon examination it appears the said Land had been taken up by Mark Bird on a prior Order and the said Owen Hugh having obtained one other Warrant for the like quantity of Land in Robeson Township in the said County dated the 25th day of Septem. 1773. Therefore In Pursuance of the said Two Warrants the Tract of Land described by the above Draught was surveyed the 18th 6th mo 1774 Situate in Robeson Township aforesaid Containing 48¹/₂^{ac} & the allowance of Six p Cent
