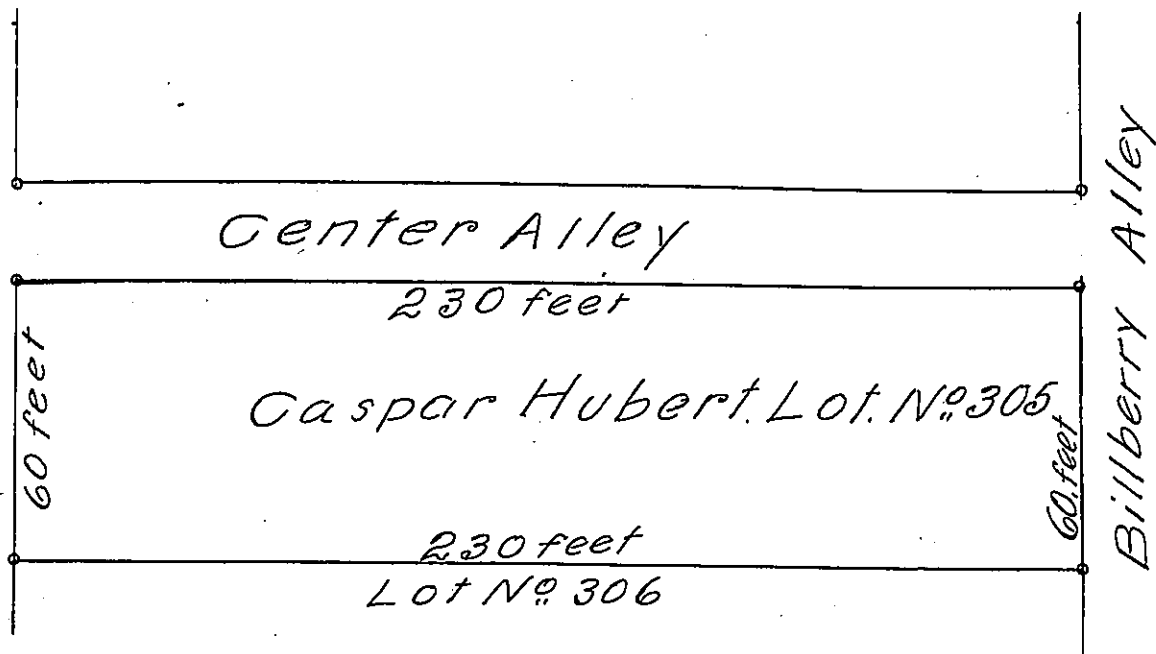


Hurtleberry Street



Billberry Alley

In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Caspar Hubert on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Three hundred & five Containing in Breadth East and West on Hurtleberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Hurtleberry Street aforesaid Eastward by Center Alley Southward by Billberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number Three hundred and Six. Returned into the Secretarys office the 19th day of December 1774 for Charles Hufty by Warrant dated the 17th of the same Month

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty seventh day of February 1905
