



A Draught of a Tract of Land called *Summerset* Situate on the  
Westerly side of the North East Branch of *Susquehanna* River  
below & joining land Surveyed for *Edward Dunlap* about five or  
six miles from the mouth of *Fishing Creek* in the County of *North-*  
*umberland*. containing three hundred & one acres & one hundred &  
one perches besides the usual allowance of 6 p Cent for Roads &  
Surveyed to and for *James Hunter* the 4 day of *June 1773*. In  
pursuance of a Warrant dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of *January 1773*
