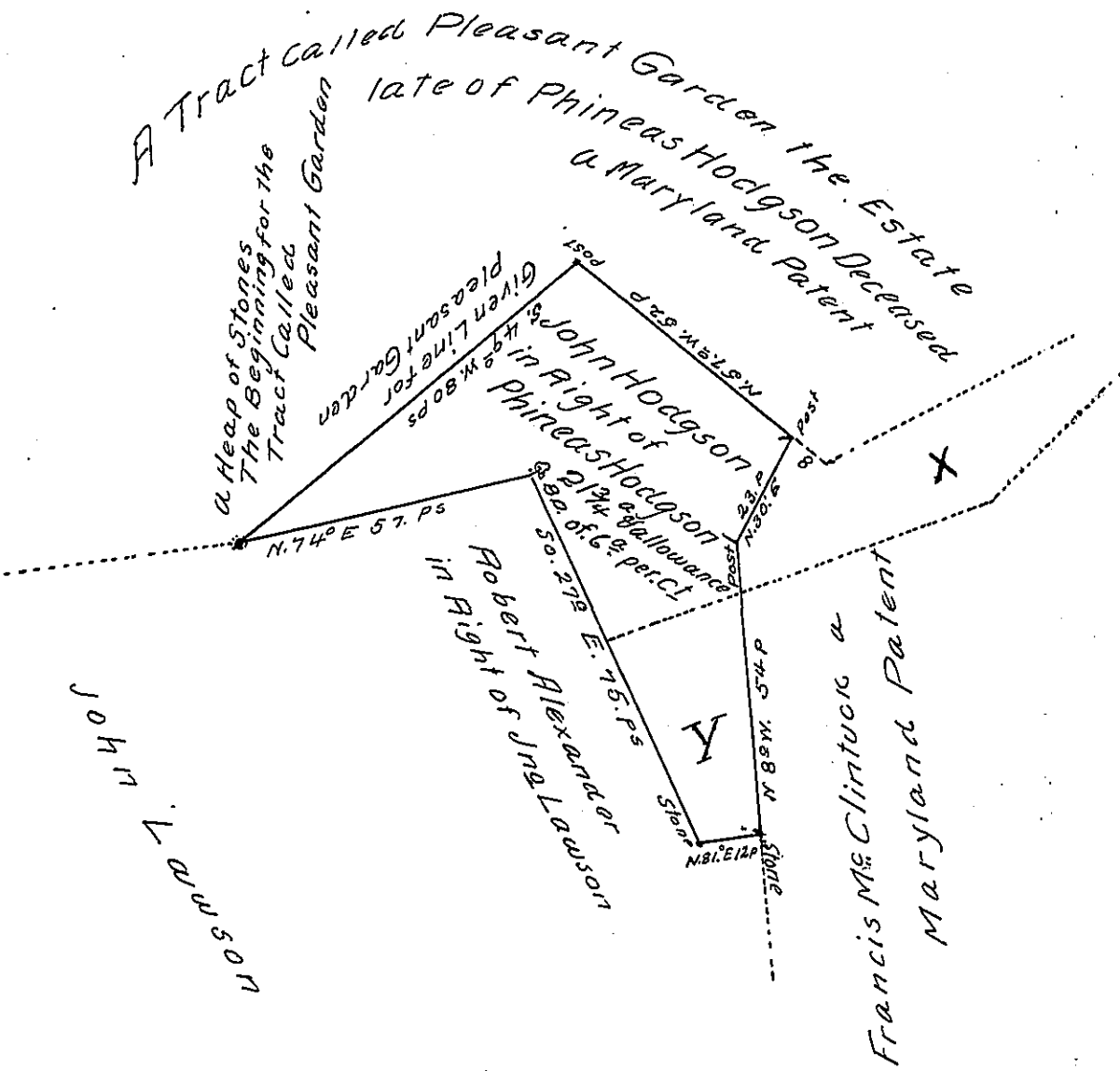

In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Phineas Hodgson bearing Date the 27th January 1756 (The Right whereof now belongs to John Hodgson.) Survey'd for the said John Hodgson the above described Parcel of Land the 12th 3^d mo 1773 to be put into the Surveyor General's office instead of a former Survey made for said Phineas — & Return'd 28³/₄^a of allowance. This includes part of the same Land, takes in a Vacancy at Y & leaves out part of the former survey at X because it has been found to interfere with a Maryland Tract of Francis McClinton's
