On the 2^d September 1737 a Warrant was granted to Rich^d Crane for 250^{ac} who not Complying &c. a vacating Warrant issued the 22^d November 1749 and 100^{ac} thereof ordered to be returned for Ineffess of which the above 50 acres are part Robert Cranes Warrant for 200^{ac} dated the 19th May 1738 of which above 100 acres are part
