



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Lower Milford Township in the County of Bucks in the State of Pennsylvania Containing Sixty Acres and 156 perches and the usual allowance of Six per Cent for Roads Being part of a Tract of 112 ac. 104 per & allowance That was formerly Surveyed to George Groner by Warrant granted to him by the Late Proprietaries Dated on the 9<sup>th</sup> May Anno-1743 - But Part of the Same was long ago Patented to Peter Hillegas, and the above Part thereof was about forty year ago Sold by the Said George Groner to Michael Hillegas, of Philadelphia, Gentleman, who afterwards, Sold the Same together with his other Land there to Peter Sholl deceased and who sold the Same to his Son Philip Sholl also deceased, to whose heirs the Same is now belonging Being under the Hands of his Executors George Weikart and Peter Sholl - formerly Resurveyed for Philip Sholl and now drawn at the Request of his Executors on the 5<sup>th</sup> January Anno-1791.
