



A Draught on one hundred and fifty one acres and thirty four perches of land with 6<sup>th</sup> Cent. part of a tract surveyed in pursuance of an Order N<sup>o</sup> 5305 granted to John Taylor dated 27<sup>th</sup> December 1768. Said to contain 310<sup>3</sup>/<sub>10</sub> <sup>ac</sup>. Situate in Armagh township in Mifflin County but found to contain only 301<sup>ac</sup> 24 perches with 6<sup>th</sup> Cent. by Resurvey 16<sup>th</sup> June 1806 in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated 20<sup>th</sup> Feby. 1806. Divided 16<sup>th</sup> September 1812.
