



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 10<sup>th</sup> December 1816 Surveyed the 7<sup>th</sup> January 1817 to Susannah Hecker the above described tract of land situate in Lehigh township Northampton County containing One Acre fifty six perches and the allowance of six p. Cent &c.

There has been a small log house Erected on the land about 20 years ago in which a family then lived but no person lives therein at this time part of the land has been cleared on which grain has been raised.
