Originally Surveyed on the 18th of the 5th month 1790. by William Kersey late D. S. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Armor Junior bearing date the 28th day of November 1771. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 1st day of June A. D. 1819. at the instance of Michael Hess the present owner who desired the same to be returned for confirmation.
