



A Draught of an Island situate in the River Susquehanna in Manor Township in the County of Lancaster. Called Frog Island about three quarters of a mile below Columbia opposite to land now belonging to Thomas Boude and another Island known by the name of Peter Labengoods Island. Surveyed the 25th day of October A. D. 1818 in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 9th day of February Anno Domini 1809. granted to Andrew Hershey
