



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 2^d of February 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to George Hughes for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4th of January 1794 Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Slippery Rock Creek Adjoining Land Granted to John Brown Called Guildford Containing four Hundred Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six p^{ct} Cent for Roads.
