Being part of a larger tract of 30 acres and allowance. Originally Surveyed on the 18th of the 5th month 1790. by William Kersey late D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Armor Junr. bearing date the 28th day of November 1771. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of Land the 1st day of June A^d 1819. at the instance of Peter Feiser the present owner who desired the same to be returned for confirmation
