



A DRAUGHT of a tract of land situate on the beaver dam branch of Clearfield Creek late in Bedford but now in Huntingdon County containing four hundred and sixteen acres and a quarter and the usual allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for roads &c^s resurveyed agreeably to the original lines & survey June the 15th 1803 in pursuance of a Warrant to John Harris dated 15th March 1785.

Note the survey made for John Harris Nov^r 11th 1785 is said to contain 399 acres but ^{by} a more accurate measurement appears to contain the quantity above mentioned.
