



THE ABOVE described two tracts of land situate in Pine Grove township Schuylkill County (formerly Berks County) containing Three hundred & fifty four acres & one hundred perches of land & the usual allowance. **A.** was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 11th day of April 1774; to George Konz, and the part marked **B.** on a warrant dated the 6th day of June 1793. Granted to Henry Huber, surveyed the above two tracts of land the 26th day of November 1794 by Philip Myer, for William Wheeler Deputy Surveyor, as the Draught in the hands of Peter Zimmerman & others owners of the said premises above described will more fully appear, I have examined the same & find them corresponding with the adjoining surveys.
