



SITUATE on the waters of Dunnings creek in St. Clair township Bedford county (formerly Cumberland county) containing 159 acres and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed by Thomas Vickroy Esq. the 2nd of June 1798. Being part of a survey that originally contained 310 1/4 acres and allowance, surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of James Harvey, dated the 3rd of June 1763.

Returned to be patented to Eli Miller, the 18th of January 1854.
