



A draught of a tract of land situate in upper milford town-
 ship Lehigh County (formerly Northampton) containing twenty eight acres
 and twenty six Perches and the allowance of 6 Per Cent for roads.
 Originally surveyed by warrant dated the 24th of April 1770 unto Chris-
 topher Goodman Mathias Ox and Jacob Dillinger in trust for use of
 the Evangelick Protestant Church commonly called Lutherians in said town-
 ship of Upper milford now taken from a draught of C.W. Wiend and returned
 for Lorentz Stachler Esqr. and Daniel Dillinger Trustees of the said land
 and Congregation In trust for the said Church Marchth 12th 1841
