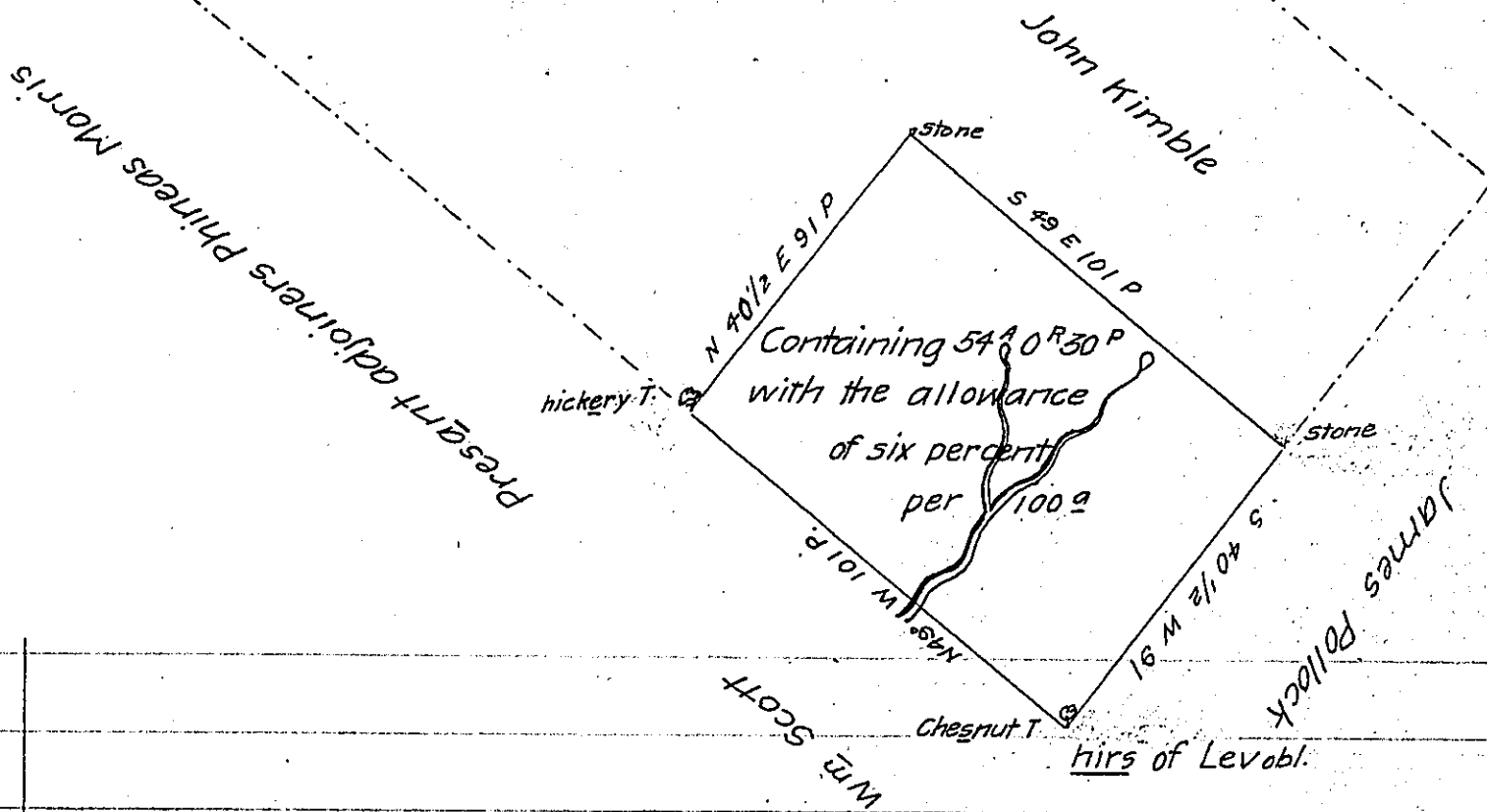


Richard Grafton

Granted Nov^r 5-1714
By Warrant.



The above draught of fifty four acres and thirty perches situate in West Nottingham Township in the County of Chester and State of Pennsylvania, being a part of a large tract containing in all 530 acres situate as aforesaid, and appears by virtue of a warrant bearing date the fifth day of November A.D. 1714 was surveyed for and granted to Richard Grafton, the above 54^a 0^r 30^p as above represented being the part by me surveyed and has been in the possession of Joseph Gyles the present holder for the term of 14 years last past. Surveyed August 22nd 1840. Given under my hand at East Nottingham
