



Survey'd to David Grier on the 13th day of June 1807 the a-
 bove described tract of two hundred and eighty four acres and one half
 of an acre and the usual allowance of six per cent on the North side of the
 East Branch of Blacklick Creek adjoining land surveyed for one Fulton on the
 South to include a large spring in Fairfield now Wheatfield Township By war-
 rant dated the 7th February 1774

N.B. that part of the above tract represented by the dotted lines
 and letters A B & C was survey'd to John Hoffman on the 5th day of June
 1786 by warrant of the 14th February 1786
