



In pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Hamilton bearing date the twenty first day of February 1811. Surveyed on the tenth day of September following unto the aforesaid William Hamilton the above discribed tract of Land containing one Hundred and thirty eight acres & one Hundred and forty one perches and nine tenths of a perch and allowance proportioned at six per Cent for Roads &c. Situate on Big Sewickly Creek adjoining Lands of John Neeper, Susana Stokely, David Sample, Robt McNamee and others, in North-huntingdon Township in the County of Westmoreland. Including an improvement thereon. commenced the first of May 1792.
