 Warrants the one granted to Gasper or Casper Herbaugh for 86<sup>2</sup> acres dated the  
 11<sup>th</sup> day of February 1800 the <sup>other</sup> Granted unto Casper Herbaugh for 200<sup>2</sup> dated the the 17<sup>th</sup>  
 day of February 1798. And Certified the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November 1812.
