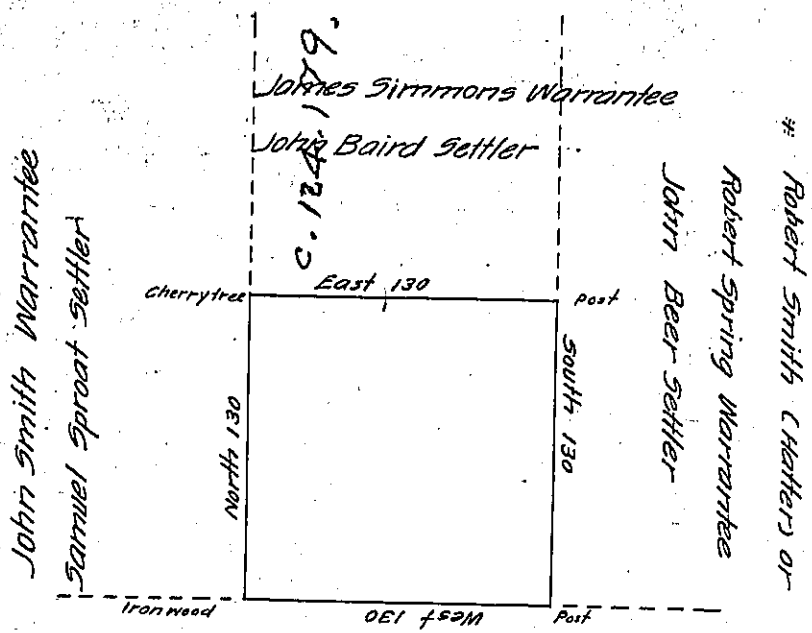

The above is a draught of a survey executed April 14th 1812 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Hartshorn, dated February 22nd 1812. Situate in the Township of Little Beaver, Beaver County, adjoining lands, Warranted to James Simmons, Robert Spring Robert Smith (Merch^t) and John Smith, Containing 99 Acres and 96 perches and allowance of six per cent

 * On the general of the population surveys which is in my possession it appears to be Robert Spring, and on another draft under seal from the Land office, it appears to be Robert Smith (Hatter) who adjoins the above draft on the East.
