



By the field notes of William Montgomery Jr. Deputy Surveyor for District No. _____ It appears that the above described tract of Land was Surveyed to James Hays on the 28th of October 1786. Containing three hundred and six Acres One hundred perches and Allowance of six pr. Ct Situate in Dunstable township Lycoming County. In pursuance of his Warrant dated the 26th of October 1785 founded on the preemptive right of Frederick Hinner, and now at the request of the owner returned this 7th of Aprile 1814
