



A Draught of a tract of Land situate on the Main branch of Tuscarora Creek in the Township of Braintrim County of Bradford containing four hundred and thirty three acres and one hundred and fifty three perches and allowance of six per cent for roads said to have been surveyed to Henry Field in the month of August 1793 which appears to have been done by same lines yet remaining Resurveyed to the same the first day of December 1812. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February 1793.
