



Situate on the South side of the West branch of Susquehanna—opposite Williamsport, in Clinton Township Lycoming County, Survey'd by order of Court on the 25th day of Octr 1803 by Henry Donel Esqr. the then deputy, for the Heirs of Galbreath Patterson Decd in Rt of Samuel Galloway No. 1335 dated the 3^d of April 1769. Containing One hundred and seventy two acres seventy two perches & allowance of 6 pr. Ct. being the upper part of the Tract, now returned at the request of the Hon^l Alexander L. Hayes
