



The above is a Draught of a Survey Made May the 18th day 1796 by John Hoge Esq^r then Deputy Surveyor containing two hundred and ten Acres of Land with the allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted Caleb Johnson the 30th day of March 1796 Situate on Godards Run a Branch of Dunkard Creek in Green Township Now Dunkard Township—Called Musgrove.
