



In pursuance of a Warrant Bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> of December 1814 was surveyed to William Jenkinson on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1815 the above describ'd Tract of Land containing Four hundred & thirty three Acres, one hundred fifty Two Prs & allowance proportioned at Six Per Cent for Roads &c. Situate in Unity Township in the County of Westmoreland.
