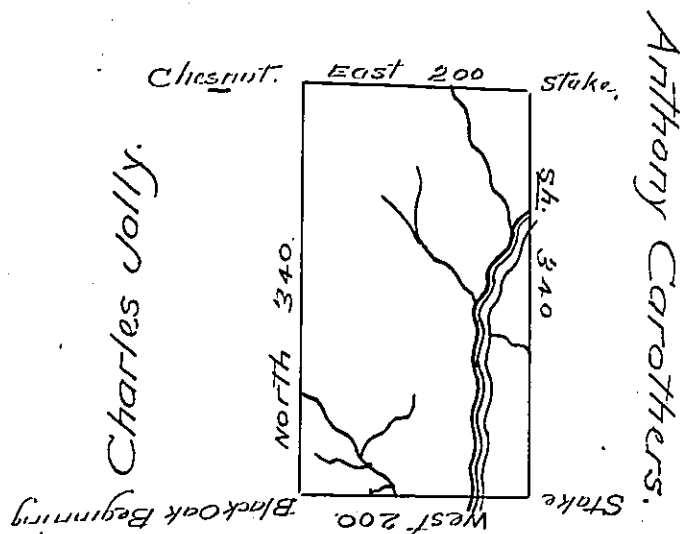

The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 29th of January 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Jolly for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4th of January 1794 Situate North and West of the River Ohio on Slippery Rock Creek adjoining Land Granted to Charles Jolly called Norwalk Containing four Hundred ⁰⁷² acres and allowance of Six P^c Cent for Roads
