The above described tract of Two hundred and fifty acres and allowance of six per cent adjoining lands of David Reed George Findley James Hart and Hugh Wiley situate on the Conemaugh River including the mouth of Richards run in the Township of Wheatfield in the County of Indiana was originally surveyed the 28th April 1790 By virtue of a warrant granted to Benjamin Jones the 12th of April 1787 which interfered with a survey made the 11th of May 1770 on Location of the 10th of July 1769 No 3634 in the name of Hugh Wiley — Resurveyed the said tract warranted in the name of Benjamin Jones on the 17th day of January 1828 Striking therefrom the said interference — By virtue of an order of Resurvey from the Board of property granted on petition of William B. Foster dated the 22^d December A.D. 1827 —
