



N^o 1 Called Bushy Hill Containing 55^a & all Situate in Codorus Township York County & Surveyed 23^d of 5th Mo 1776 for George Werner in pursuance of a Warrant for 50^a dated the 20th of February 1775 by William Matthews D^y S^r. And N^o 2 Situate mostly in Codorus Township York County Surveyed the 25th day of May 1790 in pursuance of a warrant for 30^a dated the 21st day of January 1790 granted to Peter Heary By Moses McClean D^y S^r.

I have at the request of Peter Heary laid these two draughts together that he may include them in one patent

N.B. There is more land in the above Survey than 10 P Cent surplus but the part which I must have cut off to reduce ^{it} is of such a bad quality no person would think it worth taking a warrant for Daniel Brodhead Esq^r Surveyor Gen^l M. McC. D^y S^r.
