Beginning at a Spanish Oak. By Swatara Creek Thence up a small run ye Several Courses thereof 52 Perches to a Small White Oak Thence North 28 Degrees East both by Land Late of Charles Stout 10 perches to a Black Oak &c. Containing One hundred and twelve acres & allowance.
