



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the seventh day of March Anno Dom 1737. The above described tract of land was surveyed unto John Jones in Hanover Township in Lancaster County. Beginning at a Birch by Swatawro Creek thence West ^{near} by the Improvement of William Clark 60 P. to a White Oak &c. Containing Two hundred & eighty Acres beside the allowance of six P. Cent. 17th of October 1741.
