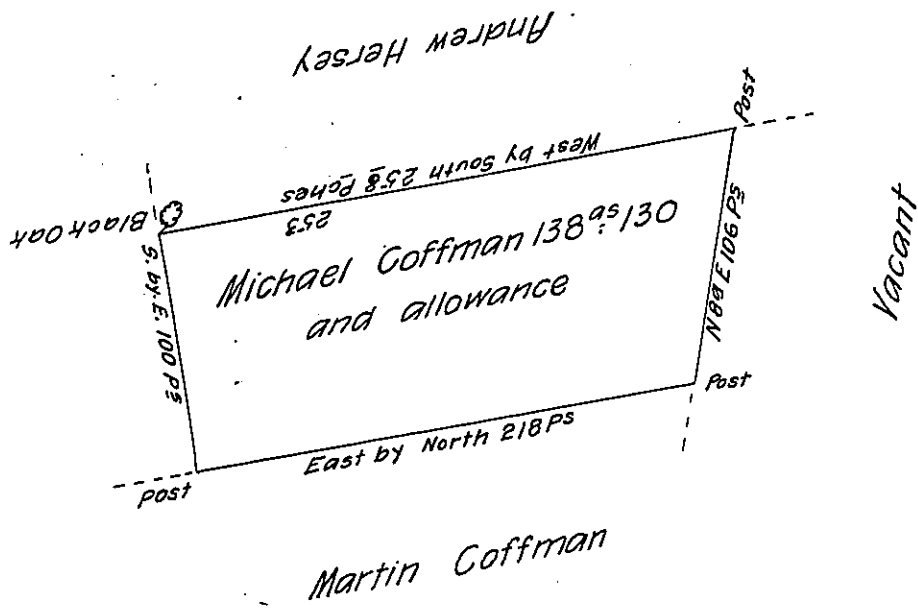

a Warr^t was granted on the 23^d day of June 1741. reciting a Survey made to Jacob Jacobs on the 29th of October 1733 by Consent of the Prop^{rs} & requiring me to accept the same &c. and to make a return into the Secretary's Office

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventh day of April 1905
