



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the second day of Novem^r 1734. Surveyed unto Adam Plank a tract of land situate in Newcowissihoppin in County of Philad^a. Beginning at a White Oak in a line of Jacob Shillhamer's land thence by Vacant land North West Seventy two Perches to a Post thence by Vacant land South West fifty seven Perches to a White Oak a Corner of Daniel Lebar's land, thence by the same North West fifty one Perches to a Post thence by Vacant land North East two hundred and forty Perches to a Post thence by Vacant land South East one hundred and twenty three Perches to a Post thence by Vacant land and land of Jacob Shillhamer South West one hundred & eighty three Perches to the Place of Beginning. Containing one hundred and fifty acres with ye usual allowance of six P. Cent.
