



Situate on Camp Creek Between the Sixth & Seventh Parallel in that Part of District No 3 to me allotted on the North side of the River Ohio being Part of the land Appropriated for the Purpose of redeeming and Paying off the Certificates of Depreciation &c Surveyed in the Month of June 1785. Pursuant to Instructions from John Lukens Esquire Surveyor Genl dated at Philad^e the fifth day of March 1785.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventeenth day of May 1905.
