



The above described Tract of two hundred and fifty four Acres & sixty seven perches of Land, and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c is a part of two

larger Tracts situate, in St Thomas Township, Franklin County, (formerly Peters Township, Cumberland County)-to wit: No 1 is part of 343,56^{as} perches & allowance which was Surveyed the 27th of May 1768. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Holliday, bearing date the 14th of December 1742, No 4, containing 2 Acres & 87 perches & allowance, is part of a larger Tract of 143 Acres & 55 perches & allowance which was Surveyed the same day in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Holliday bearing date the 6th of April 1744. Resurveyed and divided off for Malachi Brindle the 25th of November 1822.
