



Situate in Windsor Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth, the part **A** Forty Acres, forty two perches & the allowance, of six per cent for roads &c^o and the part **B** Forty acres, one hundred and forty eight perches and allowance as aforesaid. Being parts of a larger tract of 128^{ac} & allowance originally surveyed by William Matthews, late, D.S. on the — day of the — month A.D. 1767 in pursuance of a Warrant for 150^{ac} granted to Adam Haindell dated the 26th day of March A.D. 1763.

The above parts resurveyed and divided off from the larger tract on the 18th day of September A.D. 1815, by Jacob Spangler, Esq., late D.S. and now at the request of the present owner, Anna Maria Hiendle, the Draughts are examined, found correct and returned for confirmation as the Official Works of the said Jacob Spangler— March 7th 1822.
