In pursuance of a Warrant for 50<sup>as</sup> Granted to Jeremiah Barnard bearing date 24<sup>th</sup> Day of September Anno Domini 1746 And now after having Calculated, Examined and Corrected the same I am desired by the owner to make return of the Draught the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August Anno Domini 1809 (Present owner John Channel)
