



The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land situate on the road leading from Redstone ferry to Washington town on the West side of Monongahela River in Washington County called Mount Pleasant Containing 355 acres & 54 perches of Land Surveyed April the 1st 1785 for John Gripes in pursuance of a form of which the following is a copy.

Washington County March Court 1785.

A. B. Came into and proved to the satisfaction thereof that in the Month of November 1779 he obtained a Certificate from the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Districts of Monongahela, Yohogana & Ohio for 400 acres of Land in Monongahela County on the Monongahela River &c. Including his settlement made in the year 177- and that the same is lost
