



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Maccongy Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania (and but a small part thereof in Hereford Township in the County of Berks) Containing Fifty eight acres and 150 Perches of Land - together with the usual allowance of Six per Cent for Roads - That was Surveyed unto Michael Stocker.
