Surveyed for John and Peter Fidler, Samuel Stout and Isaac Boone and Joseph Fryberger the twenty first day of September, 1842, being part of a larger tract of one hundred and three acres, one hundred and fifty three perches, and allowance. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Hetzig dated the 16th day of the 6th Mo. 1744.
