



The above described tract of land is situated on the Laurel Hill in St. Clair Township Westmoreland County Penn^a including a Spring called Big containing four hundred and thirty nine acres, and the usual allowance of six per cent which was surveyed the 2^d day of October 1845 by George Meckling Esq. just Deputy Surveyor of said County for which tract of land Samuel Hill of said Township, obtained a warrant from the Commonwealth of Penn^a the 15th day of December 1863. Having carefully examined the survey as made by said Meckling and find it correct, and in pursuance of said warrant granted to said Hill, I return the survey on same to the Surveyor General's Office of Penn^a Given under my hand the 25th day of January A. D. 1864.
