



This is a Survey of a Tract of land situate in French Creek Township in Mercer County Surveyed April 26th 1827. For Ebenezer Henry Esqr in pursuance of the actual settlement and residence of Woolcot Reynolds who was present and resided on it with his Family at the time it was Surveyed, containing four hundred and thirty acres and twenty five perches, with allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. Bounded by other land of E Henry on the North, Donation Land on the East Formerly Bullions Claim, now R. Strites Claim on the South
