



Franklin County, con. Adam Hoops in right of John McKee alias McKean on Warrt. 5 June 1762. Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Green Township containing three hundred and twenty-seven acres & forty perches & allowance. Located in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the Several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented Lands under proprietary rights &c. And by virtue of an Order of Survey dated 27th October 1766 No 1683, Granted to James McKissen and John Vance for 300 acres "joining James Sharp, David McCreight, John Mitchell, Hugh McKean, Albert Torrence & William Smith. Also by virtue of a Warrant dated 18th February 1767 Granted to Adam Hoops for 200 acres." joining his other Land he claims under a Warrant of John McKee alias McKean dated 5th June 1762. Ascertained in Office 16 May 1830.
