



Draught of a tract of land situate in Howard township Centre County, formerly upper Bald Eagle township Mifflin County on the waters of Marsh creek containing two hundred and twenty-five acres and one hundred and twenty-nine perches and allowance of six per cent surveyed the 26th day of December Anno Domini 1793 pursuant to a warrant granted to John Hamilton the 13th day of May 1793, as appears by said warrant directed to Joseph J. Wallis then Deputy Surveyor and also by said Survey (not signed) remaining filed in my office dated as above, the lines examined by me the 15th day of January 1828, for the heirs of Christian Bechtel.
