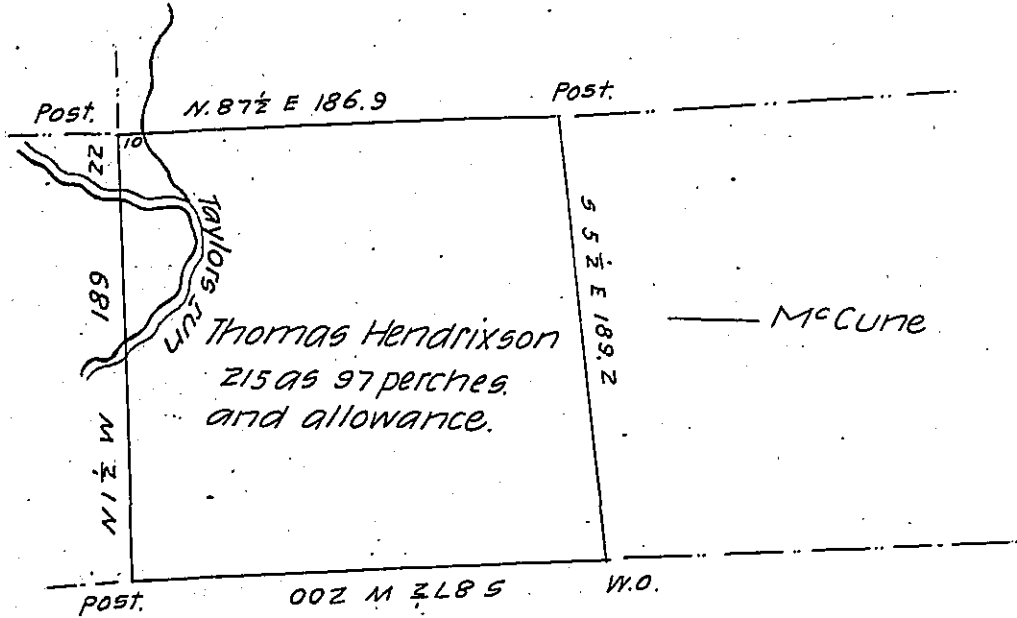

The above is a draft of a Tract of land situate in Slippery rock Township in Mercer County, being part of a larger Tract, residue on the east surveyed for Thos Hendrixson the 14th of March 1833. In pursuance of a warrant granted to him the thirtieth day of January A.D. 1833 containing two hundred fifteen acres ninety-seven perches and allowance of six per cent, &c. The time it was first settled not exactly known as Hendrixson was a late purchaser
