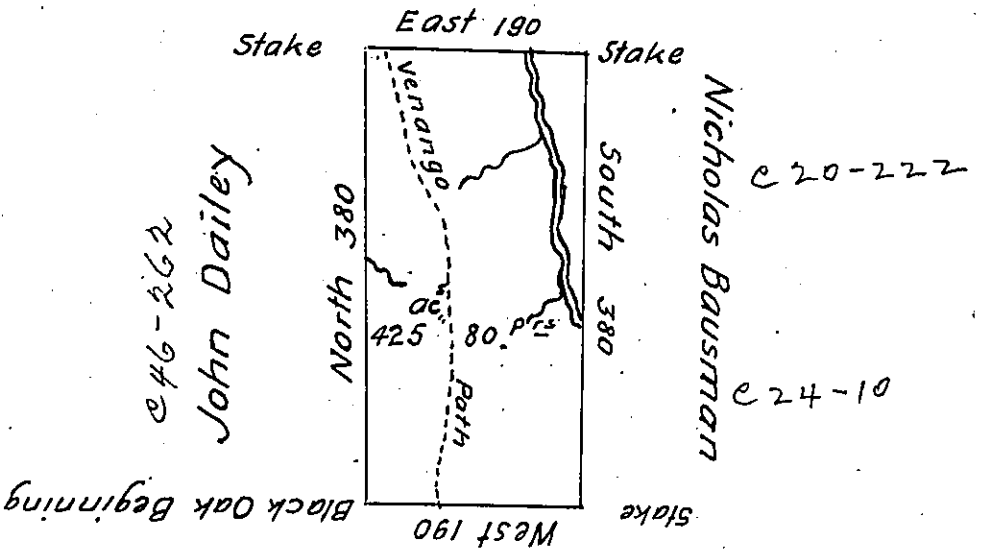

The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 15th day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to William Irvine for 400 Ac^s of Land Situate on the South Side of Canaquenessing Creek and Where Where the Verango Path crosses said Creek North and West of the River Ohio Alleghany and Canawango Creek Called Big Bottom Containing four Hundred twenty five and an half Acre together with the Usual Allowance of Six p^{ts} Cent
