



The Draught of a tract of Land situate in Ferguson & Halfmoon Townships Centre County Containing two hundred and sixteen Acres, sixty one perches and allowance of six per Cent for roads &c^a. Surveyed the 14th day of August 1811, In pursuance of a warrant granted to James Jackson bearing date the 14th day of June 1811.

The above described survey includes James Jacksons Improvement made in April 1785, Consisting of a dwelling house, barn, Apple and peach Trees, with about sixty Acres of Cleared land, and two Families now residing on the same.
