



A Draught of a Tract of Land situated in Ontrim Township Franklin (late Cumberland) County Containing One hundred and twenty five acres and fifty one perches & allowance of Six Percent for Roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of Two hundred and forty three acres and one hundred and thirty seven perches &c which was Surveyed September 24<sup>th</sup> 1767 to George Walker on his Order of Survey dated August 20<sup>th</sup> 1766 No 909 Surveyed and laid off from the other part of the Tract September 10<sup>th</sup> 1800 by Daniel Henderson formerly a Deputy Surveyor as appears by an official Draught thereof remaining in my Office.
